Background of Baoding

Baoding is a leading city in renewable energy industry located in Hebei Province. In 2006 the city drafted the idea of 'China Electricity Valley (CEV)' and started its 10-year plan of developing this valley into an integrated energy cluster with annual revenue of 77,66 billion DKK and export of 4,66 billion DKK.

Over the last three years Baoding has seen remarkable achievements in CEV's development. Six core industries emerged as the core business of CEV: solar power, wind power, power transmission and frequency transformation, power storage, power saving and electricity automation. Baoding's government put great efforts into stimulating the CEV development through favorable policy, infrastructure development and extended platform. In April 2009, the government managed to hold a "Baoding-China Electricity Valley Investor Summit" in Hong Kong which resulted in 3,81 billion DKKs contract for CEV's companies. In 2008, the CEV realized annual revenue of 20,19 billion DKK on a 46% growth and export of 5,31 billion DKK on a growth of 82%.

Currently Baoding's wind power industry has formed a complete chain containing blades, turbines and controlling systems. 4 key companies are as follows:

1. Zhonghang Huiteng Wind Power Equipment (Blade producer)
2. Baoding Huite Wind Power Engineering (Turbine producer)
3. Baoding Tianwei Wind Power Equipment (Turbine producer)
4. Guodian United Power (Turbine producer)

Background of Inner Mongolia

Inner Mongolia has rich wind power resource. The exploitable wind energy resource is about 150 GW, which is 50% of total inland exploitable resource in China.

Inner Mongolia has been ranked #1 for years in all Chinese provinces regarding installed wind capacity, which takes up to 1/4 of the total installed capacity in China.

In long term plan, wind capacity installed in Inner Mongolia will reach 50GW by 2020

Main turbine producers start to establish production bases in Inner Mongolia to be close to wind farms.

- Chinese domestic company Goldwind has a factory in Baotou
- REpower North (Joint venture) has a factory in Baotou
- VESTAS has opened a factory in Hohhot in April 2009
- Chinese domestic company Ming Yang's factory in Hohhot is under construction now

Moreover there is a Lama Temple built in the Qing Dynasty (1644-1911). It is Puhui Temple which should not be missed on your trip to Xilamuren Grassland - presenting a peaceful and harmonious atmosphere.

The temperature in Inner Mongolian is pretty low in the middle of October and the accommodation is really poor compared to the 5 star hotels. The bed served as Japanese tatami, and there is a small fire in the tent to keep you warm. There is no bath room, only local Mongolian toilet without water.

The price includes transportation to and from the hotel in Hohhot, accommodation in tents and all meals, excluding drinks. Bring good shoes, comfortable and warm clothe!

Great Wall morning experience

We leave the hotel early to be among the first to set foot on the Great Wall of China this morning. When we arrive after 90 min. drive we will enjoy our breakfast box with fresh coffee and tea before we climb the Great Wall. Cable-car is included if you want. Bring good shoes and camera!

Beijing shopping tour including dinner and foot massage
